

was 3 years old his parents removed to Grant County, Wisconsin, where he lived until he was 16 years old. He was early accustomed to the hardships of a pioneer's life. In 1859 he was seized with the California fever and made the trip there, going via the Isthmus of Panama. He remained there four years. He came back to Newton, Indiana, then to Dubuque, and in 1868 came to Cherokee County and took a home in Cedar Township, where he resided until about two years ago, when he retired and came to Cherokee to live. He was married in 1856 in Indiana, to Elizabeth Board. By this union one son was born. After the death of his first wife he was married again in Grant County, Wisconsin, in 1865, to Jennie Morrison. Nine children were born of this union, six sons and three daughters. He was a member of Speculative lodge A.F. and A.M. and of Burning Bush chapter R.A.M.
