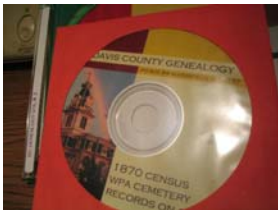

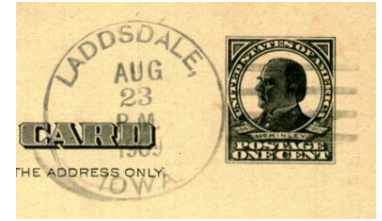

If you'd like to create photo albums that won't crumble to pieces in the hands of the next generation, choose print film and photo albums wisely.

- When photos are processed properly, they can last up to 100 years. But to be processed for archival purposes, film must be washed at least one hour. Photos processed at one-hour photo facilities are most likely not archival quality. You may want to take your photos to a custom photo lab and ask how long they wash their negatives.
- Stay away from books that have 'magnetic' pages because eventually the adhesive will fuse to the photos and ruin them
- Look for archival-quality photo albums that have acid-free pages or archival plastic
- Also, pay attention to location. Keep your albums in a cool and dry location — not your attic or basement.

Looking to create something snazzier than the standard photo album? Expressions Photo Design helps people turn photographs and memorabilia into art pieces and heirlooms. They can take 30 to 50 photographs, format them artistically, add text, then have the pages printed and bound into a high-quality faux suede hand-stitched book. ancestors.Web.site.at.expressionspd.com.

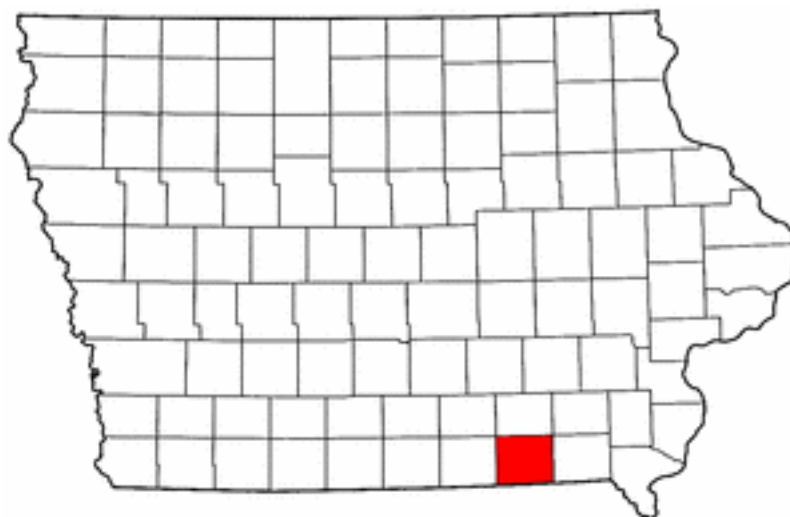
