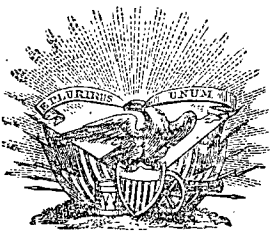

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by

the SURVEYOR GENERAL: which has been assigned to *William*  
*W Willingham*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said  
*William W Willingham*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William W Willingham* and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
