To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 52315 for 80 acres, issued in favor of *Jane Bateman Widow of Asa Bateman deceased, a Private in Captain Ward's Company of Seneca Volunteers War of 1812*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *Lots numbered one and two of the North East fractional quarter of Section four, in Township ninety two North; of Range Twenty Eight West, in the district of Lands Subject to Sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing ninety four acres and eighty two hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *which has been assigned to Daniel McCaully*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Daniel McCaully*

the Tracts of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tracts of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Daniel McCaully and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
