To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. *37954* for *120* acres, in favor of *William I Crocker, Private, Captain Powell's Company, South Carolina, Militia, War of 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the North East quarter of the South West quarter, and the West half of the South East quarter of Section thirty six, in Township twenty two, North, of Range twenty Eight, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge, Iowa, containing one hundred and twenty acres.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *The said warrant having been assigned by the said William I Crocker to Lorenzo M. Treas, in whose favor said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Lorenzo M. Treas, as assignee in officio and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Lorenzo M. Treas, as assignee in officio and his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *James Buchanan* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
