To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. *13366* for *160* acres, in favor of *Benjamin Waller, Private, Captain Saunders' Company, Virginia Militia, Mar 1812.*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the ^{South} North West quarter of Section thirty five in Township Ninety two North of Range twenty seven West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Dodge Iowa, containing one hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Benjamin Waller to William Conklin in whose favor said tract has been located.*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *William Conklin, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William Conklin as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
