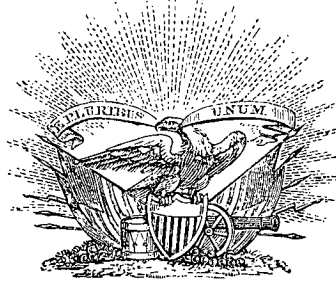


THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

heirs and assigns forever.
