

## H. REGENBURG DIES MONDAY; SERVICES TODAY

To Be Held at Uden Home and at the Evangelical Church Here

Funeral services will be held this (Thursday) afternoon at the Mrs. Uden home at 1:30 in George and at 2:00 o'clock, for Herman Regenburg who died at the Sibley Hospital on Monday morning of this week after an illness of several years. Mr. Regenburg was well known having lived here many years. He was a World War Veteran and had served in France.

Herman Regenburg was born at Moline, Ill., on the 25th day of January, 1888. Soon after his father died, at an early age, he moved to Matlock, Iowa, and lived with Mr. and Mrs. Joe A. Roth, who became true parents to him and gave him a good home. In 1917 he joined the United States Army, and served six months at Camp Dodge, Iowa, and 6 months in France, and in 1918 he was honorably discharged. He was also a member of the American Legion and was loyal to his organization to his death.

In the year 1919 on December 22, he was married to Elma Theresia Schmidt of George, Iowa, moved to a farm near Currie, MN, and lived there 16 years.
