Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. *96591*, for *40* acres, issued in favor of *James Amos, Private in Captain Halbut's Company, Pennsylvania Militia, War 1812*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section twenty three, in Township ninety three, North, of Range thirty three West, in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Fort Dodge Iowa, containing forty acres* according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:
