Kimballton — Martha Elizabeth Albertsen, was born Aug. 15, 1893 in Aroskobing, Denmark, daughter of Anders and Magdalena Petersen Hansen. She was baptized and confirmed in Denmark and was a long time member of Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton. She came to the U. S. in Oct. of 1922. On Dec. 10, 1922 she married Albert Albertsen in Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville. After farming many years on several farms in Shelby and Audubon counties, they moved to Elk Horn in 1954. During the last two years they were residents at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn. She died there Monday, Sept. 19, 1977 at age 84 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents and five brothers and sisters.
