

Ervin D. Andersen, 58

Walnut — Ervin Dale Andersen, son of Olla and Elna Rasmussen Andersen was born on a farm north of Marne on April 7, 1923. He was graduated from Elk Horn high school in 1941, was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church and was a member of Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut.

On April 12, 1948 he married Ruby Curtis Seastrom of Griswold at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Worthington, Minn. They farmed in Walnut, Kimballton, Audubon and Anita areas before retiring and moving to Walnut in 1976, when he studied real estate.

In 1980 he received his real estate license, and worked in the Walnut area for Ted Becker Real Estate. He was a member of the Atlantic Elks Lodge and the Elks National Foundation. He died at his home on Sunday, Oct. 22, 1981 at age 58.
