

## Ethel Margaret Anderson, 86

Ethel Margaret Anderson was born April 16, 1896 in Hackensack, N.J. She was one of nine children born to Charles and Rose Hayden. She was baptized and confirmed in St. Mary's Catholic church in Hackensack. She was presently a member of the Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic church in Atlantic.

In Nov., 1919, she married Max L. Anderson in N.J. They came back to Iowa where he was from and have farmed near Brayton all their married life. He died in Dec., 1977. Ethel worked in an army hospital during World War I at Camp Merrit, N.J. She also worked with the women's organization after World War I to promote Women's Suffrage.

She died in the Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic on Friday, Oct. 29, 1982 after having been ill for several weeks.

Surviving her are two sons: Max W. Anderson of Brayton and Stanley Anderson of Geneva, N.Y.; one daughter: Rose Anderson of Brayton; two grandchildren and three sisters: Stella and Irene both of N.J. and Anna of Connecticut. Preceding her in death were her parents, her husband and five brothers.

A wake service was held at the Kaltoft Funeral Home, Kimballton, Nov. 1, 1982. Funeral services were held at the Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic church, Atlantic, Tuesday, Nov. 2, 1982 with Fr. Kelly officiating.

Burial was in the Atlantic cemetery, with Emmert Johnston, Harold Hoegh, John Thielen, Delbert Killen, Richard Johnston and Arnold Bintner serving as pallbearers.
