## *ALICE M. ARENTSON*

*Alice Mary Arentson, the daughter of Nels and Mary Plumb Peterson was born February 28, 1903 in Lincoln Township, Shelby County, Iowa. She attended Lincoln Township country school and graduated from Tennant High School in 1919. After graduating, she attended normal training in Carroll, Iowa. Alice taught school at Lincoln Township No. 5 for three years.*

*On January 20, 1925 Alice was united in marriage to Eddie Arentson. To this union four children were born. After their marriage they farmed in Lincoln Township for over 50 years. Mr. and Mrs. Arentson celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary in January of 1975. After the death of her husband Eddie on September 26, 1975, Alice moved into Harlan.*

*Alice was a member of the Elk Horn Baptist Church, the Ladies Missionary Circle and taught Sunday School for 50 years at Bethel Baptist Church and Elk Horn Baptist Church. She was also a member of a social club in Lincoln Township called the Cheerful Workers.*

*On August 17, 1996 Alice died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, Iowa having attained the age of 93 years, five months and 20 days.*
