4th to 7th — Stormy in rocky mountain states and over plains eastward to Michigan-Illinois area. Mostly fair in eastern states. Some rain in Texas, thunder storms in southwest states.

8th to 11th — Blustery thunder storms along the Gulf Coast and over most of southland then fair. Stormy in New York-Pennsylvania area and northward to Maine, clearing. Fair but windy Nebraska-Kansas and westward.

12th to 15th — Unsettled in Pacific states, showers to the Dakotas and into Great Lakes section then to New England, slowly clearing. Light rain over southern plains, thunder storms through the southland to mid-Atlantic states, then fair.

Dangerous storms Great Lakes area and up into New England, clearing. Squalls in Texas and along the Gulf Coast up into the Carolinas.

24th to 27th — Hot most areas east of the Mississippi Valley. Fair, hot central and western states becoming unsettled, showers in Washington and Oregon, wet in Colorado-Utah area eastward to Great Lakes. Threatening in southwest, dust storms.

28th to 30th — Some thunder storms in Ohio River Valley to New York-Massachusetts area and northward to Maine, clearing. Hot in central and western states. Scattered showers Arkansas-Louisiana area and through southeast to mid-Atlantic states then fair.
