

The Life Story of—

MRS CATHERINE ASSMANN, 71

Catherine Assmann, daughter of Henry and Elizabeth Henus Huebert Sr., was born Febr. 10, 1903 in Panama. She died at Little Flower Haven in Earling, on July 14, 1974 at age 71 years, 5 months, 4 days. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's church in Panama and has been a lifetime member of this church. She married Anton Assmann on Jan. 20, 1925 in Panama. Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Assmann farmed near Panama and she has lived her entire life in this community except for the last three years, when she was a resident of the Little Flower Haven in Earling.

She was preceded in death by her husband Tony on July 20, 1935, by her daughter Helen on July 14, 1936; and by her parents. Mrs Assmann is survived by two sons: Leonard of Abadan, Iran and Michael A. of Earling; two daughters Mildred Assmann of Co. Bluffs and Dorothy (Mrs Urban Katzer) of the Buck Grove Community, and 16 grandchildren; by one sister - Miss Mary Huebert of Panama; three brothers, Joe, Vitus and Henry Huebert all of Panama, by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated in St. Mary's church in Panama on Thursday, July 18, 1974 with Rev. Gerald J. Stessman, her nephew of Co. Bluffs as celebrant. Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery in Panama with Leonard Assmann, Tom Assmann, Eugene Katzer, Lynn Katzer, Gerald Huebert and Norbert Assmann serving as pallbearers.
