Irwin — Theodore Axland, son of Lars J. and Kirsten Thompson Axland, was born Aug. 26, 1895 near Irwin. He attended the rural schools near his home. He married Thelma Voagen on June 20, 1930. They farmed near Irwin until moving into town about a year ago. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin. He died suddenly at his home Saturday, Oct. 29, 1977 at age 82 years, 2 months and 3 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and by five sisters - Mrs Josephine Brown, Mrs Tina Lykke, Mrs Lilly Ward, Mrs Linda Shipp and Maggie in infancy.
