# Anna C. Borgenquast, 94

Anna Christina Borgenquast, daughter of Frank and Doris Kahl Wendt, was born June 23, 1888, in Shelby Co. She attended rural schools near her home and received her eighth grade certificate from Shelby co. schools.

On March 11, 1908 she married Henry Borgenquast at Harlan. After their marriage they lived in Manilla a short time and then moved to Irwin where they farmed for Joe Woods. In 1920, they moved back to Manilla where they made their home for the rest of their lives. Henry died on Feb. 7, 1961.

She was a member of Trinity Lutheran church and the ladies aid. She also belonged to the American Legion Auxiliary of which she was a 50 year member and was a Gold Star Mother. She had been a resident of the Manilla Manor Nursing Home, for several years before she died there on Wednesday, Feb. 9, 1983 at the age of 94 years, 7 months, 16 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband; five sons: Henry, Earl, Alvin, Donald Arnold; one daughter, Helen; five brothers, two in infancy, Henry, John, Edward; four sisters, Alice Kinnaman, Emma Burge, Dora Frees, Margaret Hodder. Survivors include three children, Dorothea (Mrs Hollie H) Ham, Manilla, Alifred Borgenquast, Manilla and Arylne (Mrs Floyd) Kisling, Dietrich, Idaho; 15 grandchildren, 36 great grandchildren, 4 great great grandchildren, 2 brothers, Harry Wendt of Hornick and Herbert of Earp, Calif.; one sister, Mrs Helen Wetzel of Irwin and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 12, 1983 at Trinity Lutheran church in Manilla with Pastor Glenn Wiechmann, officiating. Burial was in the Oak Hill cemetery, Irwin with Harry Wetzel, Charles Wendt, John Wendt, LeRoy Bartenquast, Willie Hansen and Albert Albertsen serving as casketbearers.
