

The Life Story of—

Alma Beebe

Alma Sylvia Beebe, daughter of Peter and Betty S. Damand Christensen, was born July 21, 1893 in Lincoln twp. near Harlan, Ia. She died Nov. 13, 1976, at Jennie Edmundsen hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age of 83 years, 3 months and 22 days. Alma attended schools in Lincoln twp., in Minnesota and in Denmark. She later attended Harlan high school and Harlan College and then taught for 12 years in rural schools. She was married to Harry A. Beebe at Harlan on July 7, 1927. They moved to Chicago, Ill. and later returned to Harlan to farm. In 1945 Alma moved to Harlan; for the last few years she and her sister, Elva, have lived in Harlan and Sun City, Ariz.

Mrs Beebe was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Harry, and her brother, Chris Christensen. Survivors include her sister, Elva Beebe of Harlan and one sister-in-law, Mrs Chris Christensen, also of Harlan.

Funeral services were held at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan on Monday, Nov. 15, 1976 with Rev. Larry LaVelle, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with L.S. Morgan, Dick Powell, LeRoy Swensen, Mel Rasmussen, Leonard Dinesen and Wilmer E. Petersen serving as casketbearers.
