Harlan — Alice Louise Benoit, daughter of Harry and Nora Croft Kinsey was born in Harlan, on Aug. 3, 1911. She attended school and grew to her adulthood in Harlan. On Oct. 21, 1953, she married James Harold Benoit in Papillion, Nebr. They made their home in Harlan where Mrs Benoit was employed as a telephone operator for many years. Mr Benoit died on July 12, 1977, after which Mrs Benoit continued to make her home in Harlan. In Feb. of 1978, she moved to Westridge Apartments in Harlan. Mrs Benoit was a member of the Cardinal Hill Birthday club. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on Sunday, Aug. 17, 1980, at age 69 years and 14 days.

In addition to her parents and husband, she is preceded in death by one brother, Paul Kinsey and one grandson, Chad Benoit. Survivors include two sons - Jamie of Creston and Lanny of Afton; one daughter - Judy (Mrs Larry) Knudson of Irwin; eight grandchildren and other relatives.
