

Henry Blum but spons

Birth: Oct. 6, 1864
Death: Oct. 20, 1953

Henry Blum, son of Mrs Lena Blum and the late Joseph Blum, was born at Panama, Iowa, October 6, 1864 and died at his home of a heart attack on October 20, 1953.

He was married to Mary Haberberger of Earling on April 19, 1919 at Earling, Iowa. To this union were born four children; Mrs Charles Lehan of Defiance, Ivo at home, Donald of Defiance, and Mr George Stolz Jr. of Earling. Mr Blum was living on a farm near Defiance at the time of his death. He was a member of the Catholic Church and a veteran of World War I. Survivors are his wife, Mary, his four children and his mother, Mrs Lena Blum and ten grandchildren.

Services were held Friday, October 23 at St. Joseph's Church at Earling, with Rev. P.J. McStay officiating. Burial was in the Earling cemetery. Pallbearers were all nephews; Leo Gross, Jerry Bruck, Clarence Goeres, Ambrose Schneider, Gregory Haberberger and Jerry Block.
