Warren B. Brundige, 91

Warren Benjamin Brundige, son of William and Ida Brundige, was born Jan. 3, 1892, on a farm five miles north of Irwin. As a young child, Warren moved with his parents to Kans. and then later to Mo., where he was baptized at the Methodist church in Stokesbury, Mo. He attended school and grew to adulthood at Stokesbury.

On Jan. 27, 1920, he was married to Kathryn Poynter at Ft. Scott, Kans. Six children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed for a short time in Mo., and then moved to the Irwin area. This is where they farmed until their retirement in 1957. After she died on Sept. 5, 1970, he continued to live in Irwin. he attended the Irwin United Methodist church. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Oct. 29, 1983, at the age of 91 years, 9 months and 26 days.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by a grandson Michael E. Brundige; a granddaughter Jacqueline J. Storms; four brothers, Eugene, Harvey, Will and Arthur and two sisters, Nellie and Irilla.

He is survived by four sons, Robert, Donald, Kenneth and Ray all of Irwin; two daughters Betty (Mrs John) Scott of El Toro, Calif.; and Ina Mae (Mrs Jack) Willis of Rockville, Mo.; 14 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren; nieces and nephews; other relatives.

Funeral services were held Monday, Oct. 31, 1983, at the Irwin United Methodist church with Rev. Leon Wallace, officiating. Burial was in the Oak Hill cemetery with Clifford Axland, Merrill Axland, Ray Conrad, Keith Jensen, Bud Knudson and Normal Richards all serving as casketbearers.
