

### Mrs. Hulda Huebner Book

Westphalia.—Mrs. Hulda Huebner Book was born on Jan. 11, 1866 at Provins, Pomern in Lappor Kreis, Stolp, Germany, and died on Nov. 26th, 1935 here at the age of 69 years, 10 months and 15 days. She came to this country with her parents in June,

1881. Mrs. Book was the oldest of eight children and when here but a short time she began working in Harlan and other places for five years.

On Nov. 9, 1886 she was united in marriage to Joseph Book. To this union six children were born, Mrs. Clara Bissen of Earling, Mrs. Anna Luetticke of Harlan, Mrs. Dora Blum and Joe Book, Jr. and two died in infancy.

The deceased was converted to the Catholic faith at the time of her marriage. She was well fortified with the last rites of the church.

Funeral services were conducted at 9:00 a. m. at the St. Boniface Catholic Church with Rev. M. E. Duran singing the Requiem High Mass and the remains were laid to rest in the St. Boniface cemetery.
