

Martina L. Carter, 73

Harlan — Martina Luella Carter, daughter of Louie and Christena Therkeldsen Andersen, was born May 14, 1907, in Douglas Twp. She was baptized at the Lutheran church in Jacksonville, and later moved with her family to Lincoln Twp., where she finished her schooling. She then became a member of the Harlan Lutheran church, where she was confirmed.

On Dec. 25, 1922, she married Leland Carter. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan. Mr Carter died on July 27, 1975, after which Martina continued to live in Harlan. She died at her home in Harlan, on Tuesday, Dec. 2, 1980, at age 73 years, 6 months and 18 days.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by one son, Leland Carter, one brother, Carl A. Andersen and one sister, Marie Hansen. Survivors include two sons, Dean A. Carter of Co. Bluffs; and Francis Carter of Harlan; one daughter, Velna (Mrs Alvin) Jensen of Manning; eight grandchildren and eight great grandchildren; two sisters, Helen (Mrs Clyde) Obrecht of Mo. Valley and Vernie (Mrs Lake) Petersen of Harlan; nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home, on Friday, Dec. 5, 1980, with Pastor Kenneth P. Alpers of Immanuel Lutheran Church, officiating. Burial was in Harlan cemetery with Bob West, John Vithen, Bud Mitchell, Albert Wunder, Everett Maxwell and Forrest Petersen serving as casketbearers.
