IRWIN — Ray M. Carter, son of Anna Constable and Louie Carter was born Jan. 18, 1895 at Irwin. He died Oct. 17, 1975 at Denison at age 80 years, 8 months and 29 days. Ray was educated in the Irwin schools and married Lottie Gerratt June 11, 1916, at Harlan. To this union one daughter was born. Mr Carter has farmed in the Irwin area all of his life and was a member of the Irwin Church of Christ.
