Andrew M. Christensen, 76

Elk Horn — Andrew M. Christensen, son of Maren and Kristian Christensen, was born July 28, 1898 in Mors, Denmark. He came to the U.S. in 1924 settling in Shelby county. He worked for Nels Larsen as a carpenter and before retiring in 1962 he worked 16 years for Western Engineering Harlan. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church. He died on Mar. 20, 1975, at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 76 years, 8 months and 23 days.

He was preceded in death by one brother - Chris of Elk Horn and a sister - Karen in Denmark. Survivors include three sisters and two brothers in Denmark; a brother - Alfred in Saskatchewan, Canada; and a sister-in-law Clara Christensen of Brayton.

Funeral services were held on Mar. 24, 1975 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church with Pastor Lester Larson, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with Micky and Dan Nissen, Lester and Howard Esbeck, Clifford Andersen and Melvin Eskov serving as pallbearers.
