

Gaylor H. Christensen, 83

Harlan - Gaylor Horace Christensen, son of Anna Sorensen and Chris H. Christensen was born July 18, 1896 in Audubon county. He died Friday April 11, 1980 at Veterans Medical Center in Omaha at age of 83 years, 8 months and 23 days.

Gaylor was born, raised and has farmed most of his life on the same farm east of Kimballton. He served from 1918 - 1919 in the Army. He married Olivia Molgaard on Jan. 9, 1925 in Atlantic.
