## Albert Claussen

**WALNUT** — Albert Amandos Claussen was born Jan. 10, 1894 in Shelby county, son of John and Anna Weise Claussen. He married Alma Martens in Omaha on June 14, 1918. They farmed in Shelby county until 1941, when they moved to a farm near Creston. Mrs Claussen died in 1959, and in 1964 he moved to the Peace Haven Retirement Home in Walnut. He died at the Cass County Memorial hospital on Tuesday, Sept. 21, 1976 at age 82 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; a great granddaughter; a brother - Harry and three sisters, Katie Nelsen, Meta Damgaard and Amanda Fisher. Survivors include two children - Albert J. Claussen of Walnut and Mrs Joyce Waller of St. Paul, Minn.; a brother - John Claussen of Harlan; five grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Friday, Sept. 24, 1976 at Berthusen - Knudtson Funeral home in Walnut with Rev. Larry LaVelle of Monroe Methodist church, officiating. Burial was in the Shelby cemetery with Gary Damgaard, Martin Nelsen, William McIntosh, Bruce Damgaard, Charles Martens and William Martens serving as pallbearers.
