Shirley M. Davidson, 52

Harlan — Shirley Marie Davidson, daughter of Clyde and Ina Cornish Summers, was born on March 19, 1928, in Alliance, Nebr. She attended Alliance Public school and graduated from high school there in 1946.

On Nov. 30, 1948, she married Harry (Bill) Davidson in Harrisburg, Nebr. Four children were born to this union. They lived in Fremont and other Nebr. cities before settling in Harlan in 1959. Mrs Davidson was a member of Congregational Christian church in Harlan. She died at home on Monday, Aug. 18, 1980, at age of 52 years, 4 months and 29 days.

Mrs Davidson was preceded in death by one brother, Jack Summers. Survivors include her husband, Bill of Harlan; one son, Mike of North Platte, Neb.; three daughters - Karen (Mrs Bud) Henry of Cave Creek, Ariz.; Carol (Mrs Kevin) Chadwick of Harlan and Debra Lee, still living at home; five grandchildren - Bill, Shane, Calvin, Jennifer and Mandy; her mother, Ina L. Speer of Hay Springs, Nebr., and her maternal grandmother, Florence Cornish of Hay Springs, Nebr.; two half brothers - Gary Lee Speer and Robert Speer; and other relatives.
