

## Minnie M. Davis, 68

Minnie, daughter of Nels and Carolena Andersen Christensen, was born Jan. 22, 1894 in Hjorring, Denmark. She came to the U.S. when she was 17 years old to be with her brother, Emanuel, who lived near Kirkman. Before her marriage she did house work for many people in the area. On Dec. 24, 1917, she married Marshall Davis, at Harlan. They lived most of their married life on farms in Shelby and Crawford co. In 1957 they moved into Manilla. She was a member of the United Methodist church.

Her husband died Oct. 10, 1973. In June of 1977, she entered the Manilla Manor Nursing home. She died Sunday, Oct. 10, 1982 at the Manilla Manor Nursing home at the age of 88 years.

She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, two brothers, Emanuel and Andrew, two sisters, Tekla and Emma.
