HOWARD BAIRD DEEN, 65

Howard Baird Deen, son of Ada Baird and Benjamin Franklin Deen was born in Monroe township in Shelby county, on July 1, 1909 and died very suddenly at his home at Irvine, Calif., on May 30, 1974. On July 4, 1931 he married Beatrice Violet Errett and to this union two daughters were born (Ellen Ann) Mrs Elmer Paschall of Irvine, Calif., and (Sandra Sue) Mrs Steve E. Reed of Covina, Calif. From 1931 till 1946 he made his home and farmed in Shelby county. In 1946 he moved to Denver, Colo. In 1958 he moved to Oakland, Calif., and worked as a carpenter until ill health forced him to retire in 1972, at which time he moved to Irvine, Calif.
