Derald Dinesen, 64

Derald Warren Dinesen, son of Etta L. Gage and Anton A. Dinesen was born Sept. 4, 1918 in Harlan. He was educated and graduated from the Harlan high school. In 1943, he purchased a farm northeast of Harlan, near Kirkman and has farmed there ever since. Because of ill health he retired from farming in 1975.

The Virgin Prairie land on his farm has been left by him to be kept as such and dedication of this Prairie was held in July of 1978. He died Feb. 7, 1983, at the Mercy Care Center in Omaha, at the age of 64 years, 5 months and 3 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his brother, Ares G. Dinesen and his wife, Lucile of Harlan; one half sister, Signa Smith of Nevada and two nieces; Debra Doris Dinesen of Colo. and Mrs Marilyn Loundsberry of Nevada.

There were no funeral services at the time of his death, as he willed his remains to science, graveside services were held Monday, Oct. 10, 1983, at the site of the monument on his Prairie Land.

Services were conducted by the Burmeister Funeral Home.
