

Dressen accident charge brings two-year sentence

COUNCIL BLUFFS — Donovan W. Boner of Council Bluffs, convicted of involuntary manslaughter in the death of ex-Harlanite Phillip H. Dressen, was sentenced here Monday to up to two years at the Iowa Men's Penitentiary in Fort Madison.

Boner, 33, is currently serving six months of a

suspended one-year sentence given for Boner's escape from a holding room in the Pottawattamie County Courthouse, where he was being held on the original charge.

Boner was the driver of a vehicle that was involved in an accident last March that killed Dressen, 41, an Omaha resident at the time of death.
