



Vera Embree, 93

Walnut — Vera Embree was born Sept. 22, 1885 in Nebraska, daughter of Wheeler Embree and Ellen Kostenburger Embree. She received an education for elementary teaching while attending State College at Wayne, Nebr., and did some teaching, then attended college again and received a pharmacist's license in 1910. She was employed at Morehead and Salix, then worked as pharmacist for her brother, Dr. Verne Embree until he retired. She had her own drug store for several years and was later employed at a drug store and a wholesale drug company at Sioux City.

After retirement she came to Peace Haven in Walnut in 1974. She had been a member of the Order of Eastern Star and of the Christian church. In Walnut she was an active member of the Republican Women's club and attended Peace United Church of Christ. She died Thursday, Nov. 16, 1978 at the Mercy Care Center in Omaha, at age 93 years, 2 months and 26 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and both brothers. Survivors include a niece, Mrs. Frederick Young and a nephew, John Embree of Omaha, grandnieces and grandnephews, including twin brothers.

Funeral services was held at Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut on Monday, Nov. 20, 1978, with Rev. Bruno Romanowski, officiating. Burial was at Graceland cemetery in Sioux City, with Rev. Dwight Walker officiating.
