Richard Wesley Evans, the son of Vernon and Darlene Fabian Evans was born Oct. 22, 1942 in Harlan. He grew to adulthood in the Tennant area graduating from Shelby high school with the class of 1959.

Because of ill health he had been hospitalized several times, but when he was able he worked as a truck driver. He died in Glendale, Ariz. on Saturday, Dec. 24, 1983 while visiting his children at the age of 41 years, 2 months and 2 days.
