RAY ALLEN FOGARTY, 72

IRWIN — Ray Allen Fogarty, son of Jerry and Agnes Fogarty, was born Febr. 25, 1902 in Shelby county near Irwin, and died Febr. 26, 1974 at Desert Terrace Nursing Home in Phoenix Ariz. He graduated from Irwin high school in 1920 and Boyles College, Co. Bluffs in 1924. He started working for the Green Bay Lumber Co. in Irwin in 1924 and was with them until the company was sold to United Builders of Winona, Minn., in 1964. He continued to work for United Builders until his retirement in 1967. He served as manager of yards at Dexter, Dummer and Harlan and was an auditor and Vice-President at the time of his retirement. From 1967 until 1969 he worked for the Tip Top Distributing Co. of Des Moines. He permanently retired in 1969, moving with his wife to Phoenix, Ariz. He was a member of Pymosa Lodge No. 271 AF & AM of Atlantic, and the Church of All Christian Faiths, Paradise Valley, Ariz.

He married Mildred Ruhs of Irwin, July 5, 1927 in Atlantic.

He was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Delores; one brother, Alfred; and his parents. Surviving are his wife, Mildred; one brother O.E. Fogarty, Council Bluffs; three sisters Maude (Mrs Gerald Frank), Harlan; Mildred (Mrs Clifford Campbell), Co. Bluffs; Elsie (Mrs J. E. Graham), Park Forest, Ill., nieces and nephews.
