Walnut — Margaret Laurina Frahm, daughter of Jens Wolf and Carrie Jaspersen Wolf, was born Nov. 28, 1891, near Exira. She died Sunday, April 1, 1979, in Walnut at age 87 years, 4 months and three days. She married Harry Frahm of Walnut on Aug. 19, 1914 in Co. Bluffs, and the couple lived and farmed for many years in the Avoca and Walnut area. A year after Mr Frahm's death in 1977, she and her sons left the farm and made there home in Walnut. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran church in Avoca. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one grandchild.

Surviving her are two sons, Leroy and Clyde of Walnut; two daughters, Mrs Virginia Piittmann and Mrs Everett (Leona) Piittmann of Hancock; four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs Edna Brockman of Harlan.
