JOHN FREDERICK, 80

John L. Frederick, son of Peter and Mary Korth Frederick was born Mar. 17, 1894 in Portsmouth. He died Sunday, Jan. 12, 1975 at the Boone County hospital, Boone at age 80 years. He was a retired Milwaukee Rail Section Foreman and a Veteran of WWI. He was a member of the V.F.W. WWI Barracks and the American Legion. On Febr. 1, 1920 he married Bernice Phillipy in Woodbine.

Preceding him in death were his parents, one son and five brothers. Survivors include his wife Bernice and six sons: John Albert of Mason City, Robert Gerald of Boone, Donald Edward of the U.S. Air Force in Oklahoma, Bernard Joseph of Boone, Lawrence Nicholas of Boone and James Norbert of Woodward; two daughters, Mrs William (Mary) Hamil of Boone and Mrs Gerald (Ruth) Sebring of Boone; two sisters; Mrs Ann Noll of Phoenix and Miss Eva Frederick of Phoenix; 15 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.
