

**DONALD H. FREDERICKSON, 70**

Donald Harold Frederickson, son of John and Anna Mikkelsen Frederickson was born Oct. 30, 1903, in Harlan. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, April 9, 1975, at age 71 years, 5 months and 9 days. Don was a lifetime citizen of the Harlan community, maintaining membership in the Congregational Christian church and Parian Masonic Lodge No. 321 A.F. & A.M. He was also a member of the Abu-Bekr Temple Shrine of Sioux City. On Oct. 26, 1924, Don married Leta Miller in Logan. Two children were born to this union. In 1974, Don and Leta were privileged to observe their 50th wedding anniversary.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Louis. Don is survived by his wife, Leta, of Harlan; one daughter, Pauline (Mrs Allen Zemple) of Starbuck, Minn., and one son, Dean Frederickson of Harlan; three sisters - Mrs Grace Carson, Mrs Frances Owens and Mildred (Mrs C.A.
