THE LIFE STORY OF —

Christian Frederiksen, 93

Chris Frederiksen was born Oct. 3, 1888 in Hee, Denmark. He was the son of Peder and Johanna Frederiksen. He came to the U.S. in 1905 and worked as a farm laborer. On Oct. 4, 1920 he married Anna Nielsen also of Denmark, and during their married life they have farmed in this area.

During World War I he served in the U.S. Army and that took him overseas to France with the Army. They retired from farming in 1950 and moved to Elk Horn. On May 3, 1980 he moved to the Salem Retirement Home in Elk Horn and in July 1981 he moved to the Salem Nursing Home after failing health. He died at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn, Saturday, Aug. 21, 1982 at the age of 93. He is survived by his wife Anna, one daughter Ella Mohr of Omaha; three sons Arne Frederiksen of Denver, Colo., Dale Frederiksen of rural Elk Horn and Darrell of rural Exira; seven grandchildren and two great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, one infant son Borg, two brothers and two sisters.

Funeral services were held at the Bethany Lutheran church in Kimballton, Monday, Aug. 23, 1982 with Pastor Richard Dahle, officiating. Burial was in the Bethany Lutheran cemetery with Mark Frederiksen, Paul Frederiksen, Larry Frederiksen, David Thompson, Howard Hansen and Bork Kjergaard serving as casketbearers.
