

Mrs Emma Gollobit, 80

Manilla — Emma Mary, daughter of Theodore and Fredericka Koesters Schnuetgen, was born April 9, 1899 near Earling. She attended the rural schools near her home and the parochial school in Earling. She later attended the academy at Carroll. She married Thomas Gollobit in 1921 at Earling. They farmed near Sterling, Colo., for about five years, after which they moved to Defiance. They then moved to the present Gollobit farm south of Manilla in 1931. Her husband died in 1941 and Emma continued to make her home on the farm until the present time. Due to failing health she was staying with her daughter, Mrs Mary Armstrong, Omaha, Nebr., where she died on Saturday, Dec. 8, 1979 at age 80 years, 7 months and 29 days. Emma was a member of Sacred Heart Parish, Manilla and of the Altar and Rosary Society.

She was preceded in death by her husband; her parents, one brother, August and by three sisters, Mrs Mary Wartman, Mrs Louise Wartman and Mrs Odelia Gaul. Survivors include ten children — Theodore Gollobit of Manilla, Mary (Mrs Karl) Armstrong of Omaha, Edna (Mrs John) Schulte of Earling, Mrs Adelia Flores of Riviera, Ariz., Dorothy (Mrs Jerry) Schoeppner of Lancaster, Calif., Imelda (Mrs Thomas) Ward, and Joe Gollobit of Omaha, Wm. John Gollobit of Pierce, Nebr., Tom Gollobit of Omaha, Richard Gollobit of Manilla; by 59 grandchildren and nine great grandchildren and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was held Tuesday, Dec. 11, 1979 at Sacred Heart church in Manilla, with Ft. Robert Fangman, officiating. Burial was in St. Joseph's cemetery, Earling, with Gary Ward, Terry Ward, Timmy Ward, Bruce Gollobit, Gerry Schulte, David Asher, Charlie Chose and John Schulte serving as pallbearers.
