Goodner, daughter of John and Marie Sorensen was born May 20, 1930 at Guthrie Center. She died June 24, 1976 at her farm home near Kirkman at age 46 years, one month and four days. Betty attended the Harlan schools. Following graduation from high school in 1947, she married Rex Goodner and to this union three children were born. They have farmed at their present farm for the past 28 years and she had been working part time at the Salem Lutheran Nursing home in Elk Horn.
