

George H. Gregory, 84

Arizona - George H. Gregory was born in Harlan, on August 5, 1895. He died at the Chula Vista Nursing Home in Mesa, Ariz., on Saturday, April 5, 1980 at age 84 years.

He graduated from Harlan high school. He served in the Field Artillery of the U.S. Army from April 1918 - May 1919, a portion of this time was spent in foreign service. He graduated from ISU, in 1933 and soon after went into Soil Conservation work for the U.S. Government for Thurston county, Nebr., where they resided in Walthill. He retired in January 1961 and moved to Mesa, Ariz. In December, 1933 he married Neva Pearl Clark, who preceded him in death on May 17, 1979. He was a member of the Velda Rose Methodist church in Mesa; a 50 year member of the Masonic Lodge at Walthill, Nebr.

Survivors include his brother - Roy of Youngtown, Ariz., a sister - Grace of Shreveport, La., and a sister - Gladys of Sacramento Calif., and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, April 8, 1980 at Gibbons - Bunker Mortuary in Mesa. Burial was in the Mesa City cemetery.
