

Selma P. Grulke, 90

Avoca — Selma Pauline Grulke, daughter of Pauline Lorenzen and Richard Podaak was born March 8, 1890 in Walnut. She died Tuesday, Aug. 5, 1980 at the Colonial Manors Nursing Home in Avoca at age 90 years, 4 months and 27 days. Selma was educated in the Walnut schools.

On Nov. 5, 1913 she married Ernest S. Grulke in Atlantic. This union was blessed with two children. They farmed six miles west of Atlantic until 1928, when they moved to Avoca. They resided there for over 50 years. She was the only living chartered member of the Avoca Garden club.

She was preceded in death by her parents, a step-father - Henry Namanny, one brother - Max Podaak and one son - Paul.
