PERSIA — Tena M. Hamann, daughter of William and Marie Oloff, was born Aug. 26, 1890 at Portsmouth. She died July 9, 1974 at Swedish hospital in Englewood, Colo., at age 83 years, after a brief illness. She was baptized and confirmed in the Trinity Lutheran church in Persia. On Mar. 12, 1913 she married William Hamann. This union was blessed with five daughters. They farmed in Persia 47 years and moved to Denver, Colo., in 1960. Mr and Mrs Hamann observed the 60th wedding anniversary last year.

She was preceded in death by her husband, William in Mar., her parents, two brothers - William and Henry and a sister - Delia Maaske.
