

Betty Hansen, 53

Elk Horn — Betty (Mrs Kenneth) Hansen, daughter of Jens and Anna Fries, was born Oct. 16, 1925 in Elk Horn. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. She graduated from Elk Horn high school and attended Iowa State Univ. and graduated from the Univ. of Nebr. in Lincoln.

On Aug. 31, 1947, she married Kenneth Hansen in Elk Horn. This union was blessed with four children. They both taught at the Fairfield, Nebr., high school. Later they lived at Hebron, Broken Bow and North Platte before locating in Omaha, 23 years ago. He continued in educational work, while Betty, before being invalided, worked for a number of years as a technician in an Omaha food processing plant.

She died Sunday, Sept. 16, 1979, at Bishop Bergan Mercy hospital, Omaha, Nebr., after a lengthy illness, at age 53 years.
