Hansen was born Oct. 17, 1900 in Sharon twp., Audubon county, daughter of Anders and Anne Simonsen Jensen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran church. She married Frank M. Hansen in Omaha in Nov. 1931. One child was born to this union, Karen Ann, who died at the age of seven years. They lived in Omaha for several years and in 1947 bought her home place where they continued to live after selling the farm. Mrs Hansen died at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn on Saturday, Febr. 15, 1975 at age 74 years.

She was preceded in death by her husband-Frank on Jan. 12, 1975 and her daughter, Karen. Survivors include three sisters - Astrid (Mrs Ray LaMaster) of Kimballton; Gunda Jensen of Inglewood, Calif., and Eleanora (Mrs Russell Booth) of Inglewood, Calif.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Feb. 18, 1975 at the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton with Pastor David L. Peterson and David LaMaster, officiating.
