Jackson — Gladys Elizabeth Hansen, daughter of Ed and Grace Euwin Doran, was born on a farm in Ill., on May 20, 1902. At the age of 12, she moved with her parents to Bayard, where she finished school and grew to adulthood. She attended the Bayard Christian church.

On Feb. 1, 1931, she married Ernest Hansen in Bayard. One son, Forrest Hansen was born to this union. He now resides in Harlan. After their marriage, they farmed in Shelby county near the town of Jacksonville. She died at her home near Jacksonville on Friday, Oct. 24, 1980, at age 78 years, 5 months and 4 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents. Survivors include her husband and son, five grandchildren; five great grandchildren; one sister, Jane (Mrs John) O'Brian of Fork River, N. J.; two brothers, Gerald Doran of Stors, Conn., and Wilbur Doran of Perry and other relatives.
