Mrs Ole A. Hansen, 77

KIMBALLTON — Mrs Myrtle Hansen, daughter of Jorgen and Andrea Kallesen Hartvigsen, was born July 12, 1897 in Sharon township in Audubon county. She attended the Audubon county rural schools. On Mar. 15, 1922 she married Ole A. Hansen in Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton. Mrs Hansen was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. She was an active member in the Lutheran church women activities and was active in the Kimballton Senior Citizens club. She died Friday, Febr. 7, 1975 at Bishop Clarkson hospital in Omaha, Nebr., at age 77 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents; three sisters - Mrs Chris (Marie) Juel, Mrs Gomer (Ediel) Bittle and Solveg Hartvigsen and her husband - Ole, who died in 1960. Survivors include - her niece Mrs Waldo Johansen and granddaughter - Tami Johansen of Harlan; two sisters - Mrs Clara Andersen of Centerville, So.
