

OLE J. HANSEN, 86

**KIMBALLTON** — Ole J. Hansen, was born July 16, 1889 in Jackson twp, Shelby county, son of Nels and Sophie Jacobsen Hansen. He was baptised and confirmed in the Bethlehem Lutheran church, Jacksonville. On Febr. 16, 1916 he married Marie Mathiesen. They farmed two miles west and 1/2 north of Kimballton and moved into Kimballton, Apr. 22, 1947. Ole was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church since 1936. He served as a director of the Landmands National Bank. He died at Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic on Wednesday, Dec. 31, 1975 at age 86 years.

He was preceded in death by his wife - Marie in 1959, one brother and one granddaughter. Survivors include three sons: Orville rural Kimballton; Lyle of Des Moines and Dallas Hansen of Honey Creek, by one daughter - Ardell (Mrs Merle) Hansen of Brayton; 15 grandchildren; two great grandchildren and one sister - Caroline Hoogensen, Salem Home.
