

# Peter D. Hansen, 78

**KIMBALLTON** — Peter Damgaard Hansen, son of Anna Katrina Damgaard and Lars Peter Hansen was born Sept. 14, 1899 in Varladegaard, Denmark. He died Sept. 19, 1977 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 78 years and five days. Peter was baptized, confirmed and educated in Denmark and in 1920, at the age of 21 he immigrated to the U.S. and settled near Blair, Nebr. He married Alice Petersen in 1931 at Fremont, Nebr., and to this union four children were born. Mr Hansen has farmed for 50 years in Washington and Douglas counties in Nebraska and in Harrison and Shelby counties in Iowa before his retirement to Kimballton in 1973.

Mr Hansen is preceded in death by his parents, two brothers - Eske Calle and Axel and one sister in Denmark. Survivors include his wife Alice of Kimballton, two daughters - Mrs Jeanette Dugger of Omaha, Iona (Mrs Jim Stratbucker) of Ft. Calhoun, Nebr., two sons - Florian Hansen of Audubon and Arlo Hansen of Glenwood, by one brother - Hans K. Hansen of Norfolk, Nebr., 12 grandchildren, six great granddaughters, nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Sept. 21, 1977 at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan with Pastor David L. Peterson of Immanuel Lutheran church, Kimballton, officiating. Burial was in Immanuel Lutheran cemetery in Kimballton with Morris Cox, David Dugger, Marlin Dugger, Steven Dugger, Ronald Hansen and Richard Hansen, all grandchildren serving as casketbearers.
